

SHOA GARAGE DOOR Painting Rules

All replacement garage doors must be painted appropriately to match house paint exterior colors. Factory default colors are not acceptable. If you are in doubt about color choice or placement, please contact the ACC chairperson for assistance.

2002 Exterior Paint Scheme:

The desired outcome is a 3 color appearance as viewed from the front of the home. Two painting options are available.

Garage door in *one color*

This is a more contemporary look.

Garage door trim is painted color #3.

Garage door is painted color #2 if main body is color #1

Garage door is painted color #1 if main body is color #2 [flipped scheme]

Note: a few houses in Sugarloaf have an architectural style in which the accent color surrounds the garage door trim. In such cases, the garage door color will be impacted. Please contact the ACC chairperson for assistance.

Garage door in *two colors*

Garage door trim is painted color #3.

Garage door horizontal and vertical areas surrounding the panels are painted same color as main body color

Garage door panels are painted in the accent color

panels are painted in color #2 if main body is color #1

panels are painted in color #1 if main body is color #2 [flipped scheme]

Note: a few houses in Sugarloaf have an architectural style in which the accent color surrounds the garage door trim. In such cases, the placement of the two colors will be impacted. Please contact the ACC chairperson for assistance.

1980s Exterior Paint Scheme:

Garage door in *one color*

Garage door trim is painted trim color. Garage door is painted in either trim or stucco.

Garage door in *two colors*

Garage door trim is painted trim color. Garage door horizontal and vertical areas surrounding the panels are painted trim color. Garage door panels are painted in stucco color.
