ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE

Painting Reminder - if you are planning to re-paint your home, please note that you must submit an architectural project form for approval. This process ensures 1) no mistakes are made in paint color selection (which could be expensive if corrections are

needed), 2) neighbors are notified of the project, since it may require access to their property and/or generate noise and debris, 3) the association can maintain an accurate database of home colors (useful for future owners). The painting program guidelines are available at our website. Also, some owners are finding balconies that need significant repairs and renovations. Please remember to submit an architectural project form for balcony repairs/renovations, and note that the balconies need to be painted in the existing trim color. Thanks for your cooperation.

LANDSCAPE

In addition to standard activities, the following work was or will be performed in common / easement areas during November / December:

- Repaired minor irrigation problems around the development
- Completed work on trees that had been identified as needing attention through our large tree survey program
- Crew is uncovering small drains in the common / easement areas on Parkwood and Toyon Court
- Will be testing surface drains off of De Anza to make sure they are working
- Weekly trash removal along sidewalks
- Landscape irrigation has been turned off for the rainy season.

The city of San Mateo is considering updating leaf blower laws. The current law (1997) allows leaf blower use M-F 8-5, Sat 9-5. Different options are being considered in city study sessions. If interested in more information, visit the city's website or contact the management analyst for the project, Christina Gilmore – <u>cgilmore@cityofsanmateo.org</u>. The Board is awaiting city direction on this topic.

As a reminder, owners or their landscapers may not dispose of yard waste or trimmings on HOA common space. This is illegal dumping and will not be tolerated. Owners will be assessed cleanup fees if the HOA needs to perform cleanup.

Finally, please do not trim/cut any trees in the common areas. Branches from common area trees that overhang a homeowner's yard are not trimmed by the HOA unless they present a fire hazard. If you want to trim for view (at your cost), or have a concern, call PML or talk to a Board member. We have a process to follow. The first step is for you to identify the work you would like done. The HOA has a list of approved arborists/firms that can perform work on HOA trees. You would submit a quotation from one of these approved firms to the HOA for board approval before any work is performed. Thanks for your cooperation.

TRASH / RECYCLING – PLEASE FOLLOW CC&Rs & CITY LAWS

Please remember that, per CC&Rs Section 5.08 (and per SM City Code!), your trash and recycling bins need to be kept out of sight, except on pickup day or the day prior. They may not be stored anywhere in sight from a street, neighboring lot, or common area. Let's all help keep the neighborhood looking nice.
